



ISM Internal Auditor

A course for personnel who needs to be qualified as an internal auditor or would like to know more about this subject, e.g. safety and quality co-ordinators in shipping companies, DPA's (Designated Person Ashore) and technical personnel. Upon completion the participants will have gained knowledge about the requirements for internal audits and be familiar with procedures, auditing tools and techniques.

Pre-requisite:

Participants should have knowledge on the ISM Code Implementation.

Teaching Method:

The Internal Auditing course is a combination of lectures, exercises, case discussions, role-playing and interactions among participants. The emphasis is given on a practical case study for a shipping company and a ship. Active involvement will add to the learning, benefits for individual participants and will be dependent upon the open sharing of shipping industry experience. Practical knowledge on how to conduct audits, including auditing practices guidance, preparation, execution and follow-up are provided through lectures and workshops.
