#### **NEWBUILDING**

Starting with Dry, there are further orders to report this week in the Capesize sectors with SWS taking a further order for two firm 180,000 DWT Capes from Sincere Navigation. Pricing is understood to be USD 46.8 Mill with delivery of both vessels in the second quarter of 2016. Moving down the sizes, Jiangsu New Yangzijiang have reportedly placed an order for 1+1 94,000 DWT Self-Unloaders from Oldendorff Carriers, with delivery of both the firm vessel and option for delivery in 2015 if declared. It has also come to light this week that Ultrabulk have contracted a single 81,000 DWT Kamsarmax again at an undisclosed Japanese yard and with delivery in 2015. Just one order seen this week in the Supramax sector with again Ultrabulk reportedly ordering a single 61,000 DWT Supra at an undisclosed Japanese yard. No pricing was disclosed however delivery is lined up for 2016. In the smaller sizes Korean owned Weihai Samjin has seen a number of options declared boosting their already significant Handysize orderbook. A joint venture between Ultrabulk Shipping and Norwegian Shipping Fund, Maritime Opportunities, are understood to have declared an option for a second 36,000 DWT Handysize at the yard with delivery planned for 2015. Oldendorff Carriers are also understood to have declared options at the same yard, declaring the 3rd and 4th options in a series of 36,000 DWT Handysize. These latest vessels are lined up for delivery in 2014, with the first two in the series due to deliver later this year.

In other sectors, understood to have been signed at the end of last month, it has come to light this week that Pacific International Line (PIL) have placed an order for two firm 1,400 TEU MPP vessels at Taizhou Kouan. Delivery of the 27,000 DWT vessels is planned from mid-2014 and continues the Buyer's ordering at this yard having taken delivery of four MPPs of the same size over the past year. Finally, Wilh. Wilhelmsen have placed an order for two firm plus two option 7,930 CEU PCTCs at HHI in Korea with delivery of the firm vessels in 2014 and 2015 and options into 2015 if declared.
