

ATLANTIC CAPE SIZE INDEX

10 February 2014

After declining for five consecutive weeks, last week saw the Atlantic Capesize Index up by 96 points to 5,792. Atlantic round voyage rates climbed by \$800/day last week to \$6,500/day. However, fronthaul rates declined further, edging down by \$300/day to \$26,200/day.
