

ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

17 March 2014

The Atlantic Capesize Index slipped by 285 points week-on-week to 8,704. However, this is still more than 3,300 points higher than the previous year. Atlantic round voyage rates were unchanged from the previous week, at \$25,000/day, while fronthaul rates fell by \$3,000/day to \$41,000/day.
