

ATLANTIC CAPE SIZE INDEX

22 April 2014

The Atlantic Capesize Index fell to its lowest level since June 2013 last week. Declining 428 points week-on-week to 5,411. However, it is still 265 points above the year-ago level. Atlantic round voyage rates continued to decline, falling \$1,800/day to \$4,700/day. Fronthaul rates fell from \$25,250/day to \$22,000/day last week.
